See, Think, Wonder

See, Think, Wonder is an observation tool that supports educators and caregivers in noticing, honoring and responding to a child's unique learning style and capabilities.

What do you see?

- Take note of exactly what you see and hear in baby's play.
- Describe baby's physical movements, gaze and sounds.
- Describe baby's interactions with others (adults and peers)

What do you think about that?

- What does this make you think about the baby's intentions and interests?
- What questions do you think the baby is asking about their world?
- What evidence of infant development and learning do you see?

What does it make you wonder?

- What questions does this spark for you about this child's learning or interests?
- Does this observation spark any ideas for materials or experiences to further support the child's play?

See, Think, Wonder is an observation protocol developed by Harvard University's Project Zero.
